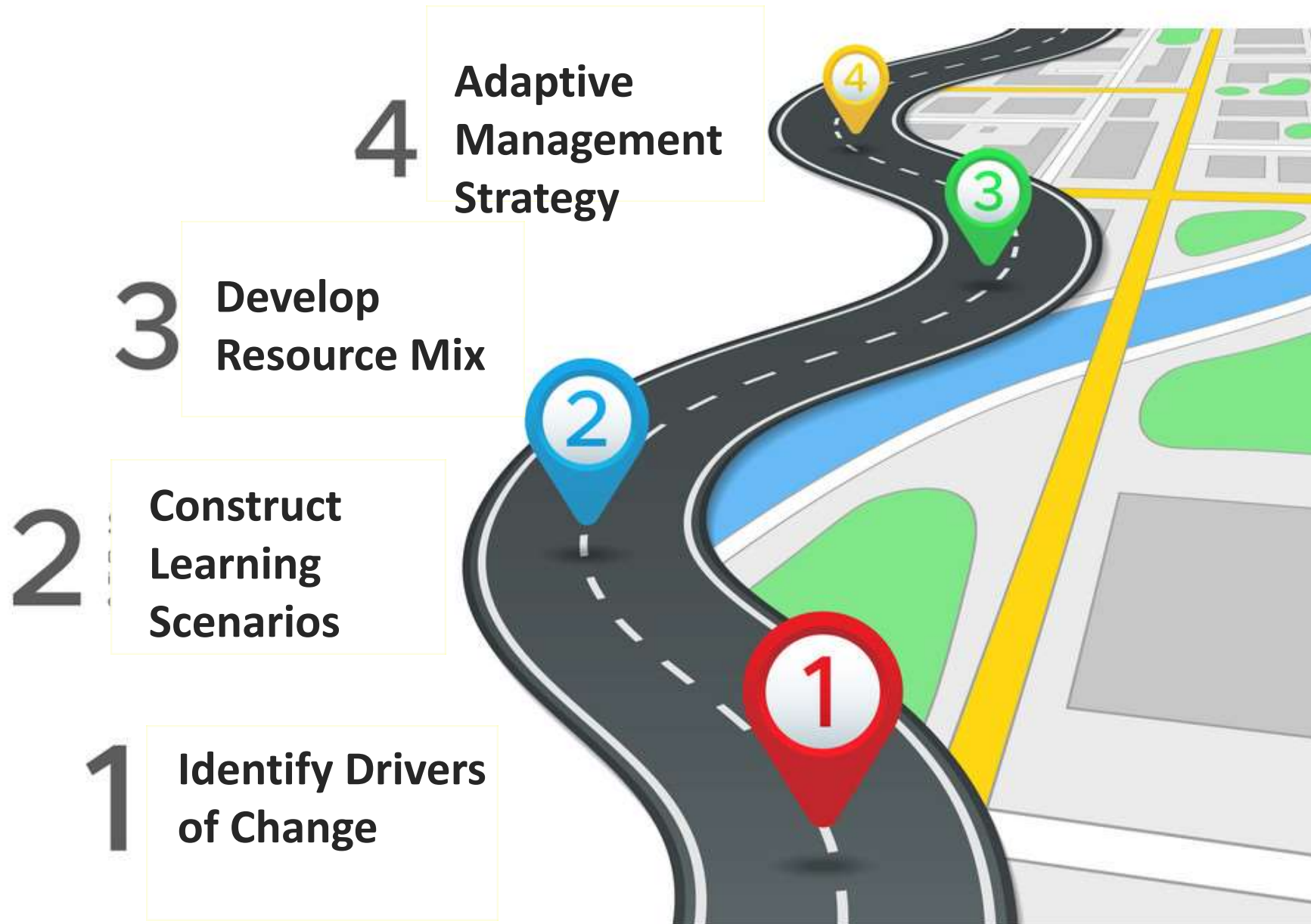

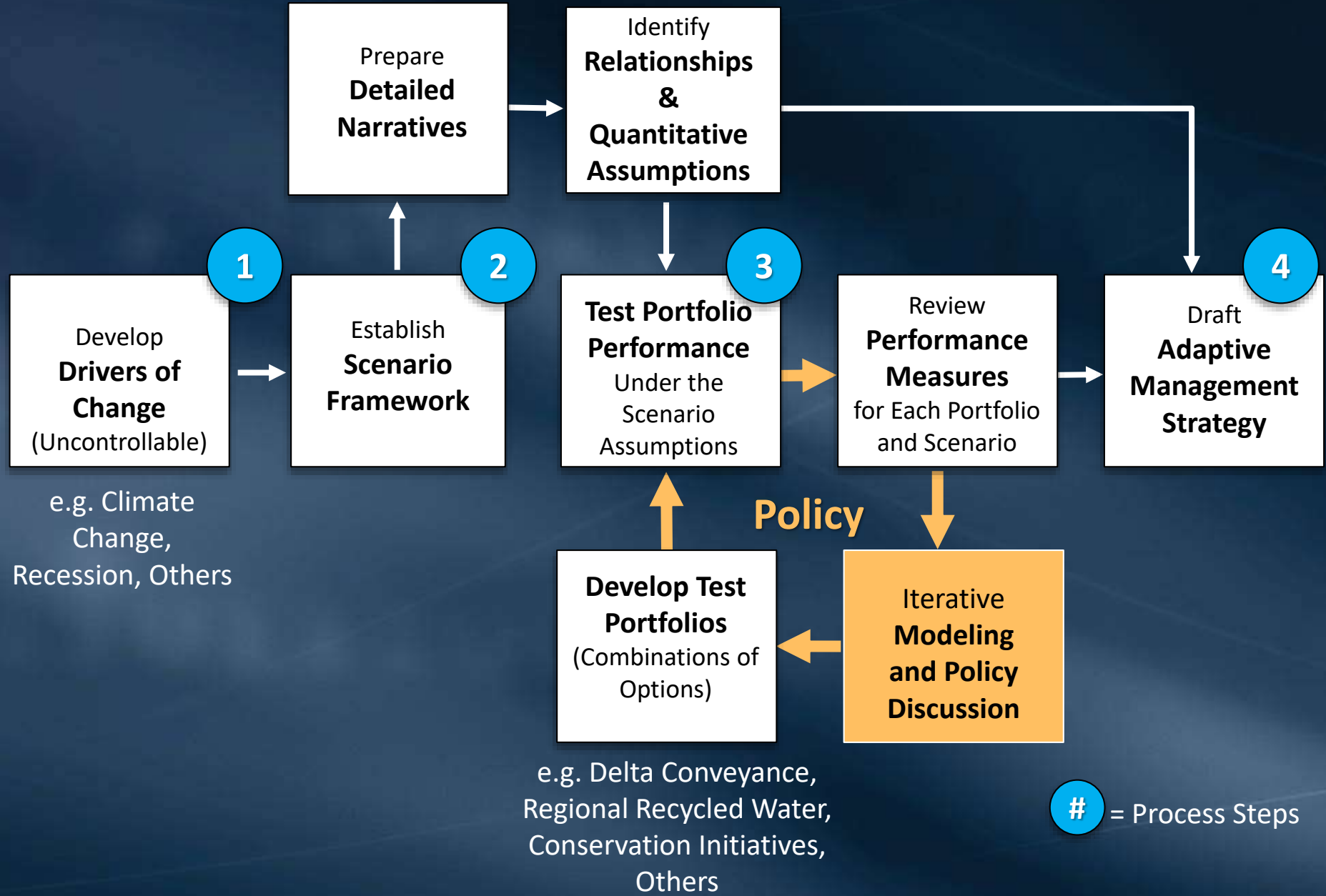

2020 IRP Roadmap



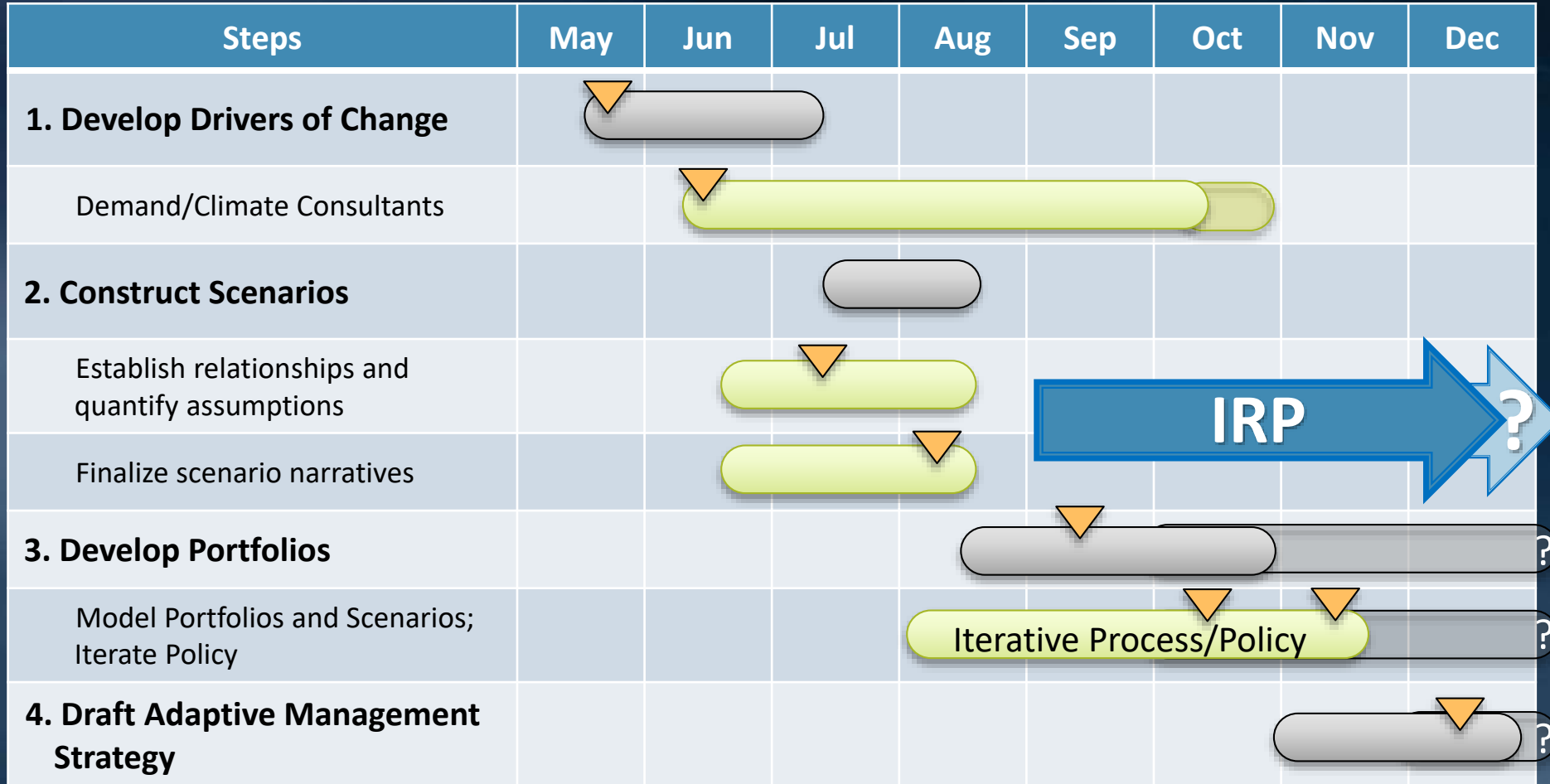
2020 IRP Process Flow Chart
