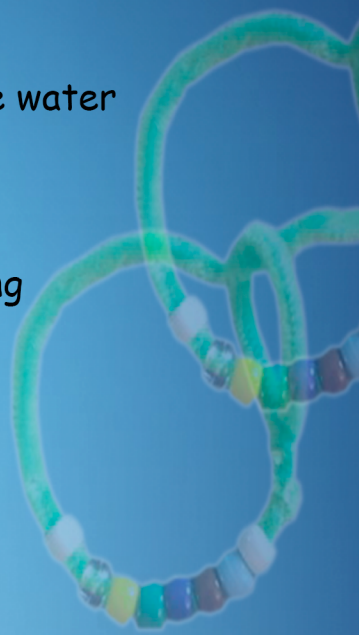


WATER CYCLE BRACELET ACTIVITY

Did you know that the water we have on Earth now is the same water that the Dinosaurs drank a long time ago?

The water is constantly moving... it can change from a liquid to gas (vapor) and/or to a solid (ice). Water renews itself by going through different processes which can include: evaporation, condensation, precipitation, accumulation, surface runoff and transpiration. This is known as the Water Cycle.

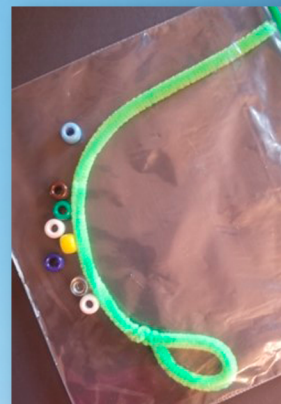
In this activity, you will be using beads to make your own water cycle bracelet.



Let's get started!

Bracelet Kit contains the following:

- 8 colored pony beads: 1 each of light blue, dark blue, green, yellow, clear, brown and 2 white
- 1 pipe cleaner/chenille stem

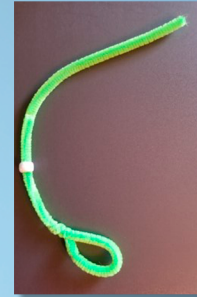

BRACELET KIT INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1

Each bead represents a part of the "Water Cycle". You will be adding the colored beads one at a time in the following order:

White bead	Clouds (condensation)
Light Blue bead	Rain, snow, hail (precipitation)
Brown bead	Ground (accumulation)
Dark Blue bead	Water in oceans, river, lakes (surface runoff)
Green bead	Plants evaporate water through leaves (transpiration)
Yellow bead	Sun (source of energy, powers the water cycle)
Clear bead	Water vapor/gas (evaporation)
White bead	Clouds (condensation)

Step 2

Wrap around wrist and take the straight end of the pipe cleaner and put through the loop on the other end and close
